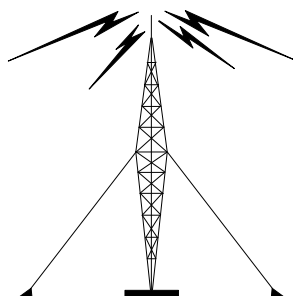

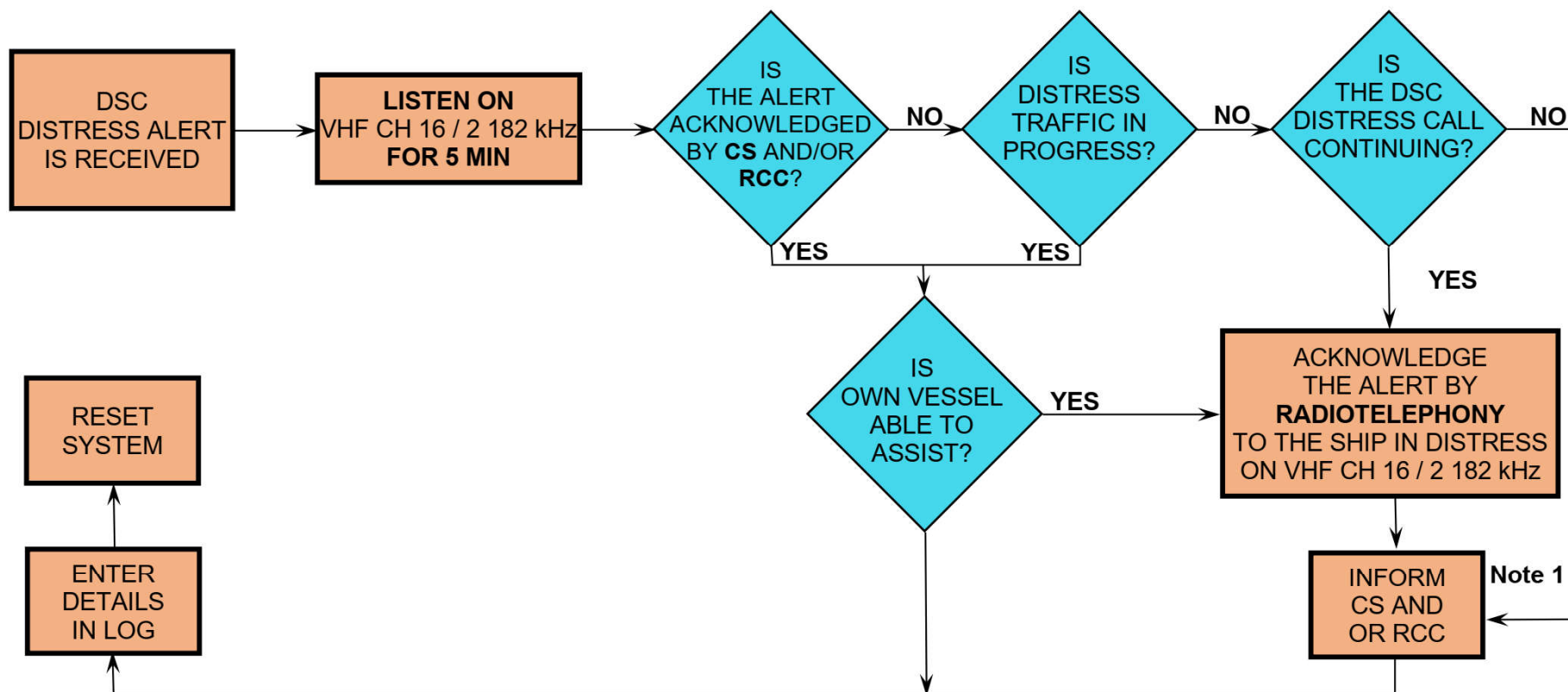

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ACTIONS BY SHIPS UPON RECEPTION OF A **VHF / MF DSC** DISTRESS ALERT**REMARKS:**

Note 1: Appropriate or relevant RCC and/or coastal station should be informed accordingly. If further DSC distress alerts are received from the same source and the ship in distress is beyond doubt in the vicinity, a DSC acknowledgement may, after consultation with an RCC or coastal station, be sent to terminate the call.

Note 2: In no case is a ship permitted to transmit a DSC all ships distress alert relay on receipt of a DSC distress alert on either VHF channel 70 or MF channel 2 187.5 kHz.

CS = coastal station

RCC = rescue coordination centre

Meteorological Warnings (where a weather bulletin service is provided) and Urgent Navigational Information (including SAR information) will additionally be broadcast on receipt and at the next scheduled broadcast time whilst still in force.

The approximate NAVTEX operational range is shown in nautical miles for each station.
